

Lone Wolf District Officer Application 2022

The 2022-2023 Lone Wolf District Officer Team will be selected by a panel of judges at the District Degree Check in Ira on May 5th @ 2:30pm. Members applying for a district office must be completing their sophomore or junior year of high school. Members must be completing at least their second year of ag class.

There is no limit to the number of candidates each school may have. Each candidate will submit an application and participate in a personal interview with a panel of judges at the check; thus it is mandatory that all candidates attend the District Degree Check. The judges will use the interview scores and applications to select 7 or more officer candidates to present speeches to the Lone Wolf Delegation. District officers do not take a test and the judges' decision will be final. Following the announcement of the seven or more officer candidates, they will each present a three minute speech to the voting delegates who will then vote for who they want to represent them as President, Vice President, etc. The results will be tallied by a group of agricultural science teachers and results will be announced at the District Banquet. IMPORTANT: All applications must be submitted by the advisor. District officer applications must be emailed to lsellers@ira.esc14.net and cory.rains@sweetwaterisd.net by April 28th in PDF form. This will allow judges time to adequately review applications and speed the selection process.
